

Our Gang Ice Racing

Summary of Changes for the 2024 Season

There wasn't a need for a lot of big changes this year, so we just made a couple of tweaks to existing rules and increased the prices a bit as a result of changes to Georgetown's fees.

Competition Division Championship Points

In prior seasons, a Championship Points race was held for the Competition Division as a whole, meaning that points from each class (Bare Rubber, Studs, and Cheaters) were added together in order to recognize an overall leader and runner-up for the division.

Going forward, we will be holding a Championship Points race for each class, as we had previously done for the Street and Pro Street Divisions. So, in 2024, we will recognize leaders and runners-up for Competition Bare Rubber, Competition Studs, and Competition Cheaters independently of one another.

Points Earning Clarification

In order to receive points, the driver must give a ready nod to the Center Ice Official and the vehicle must pass through the start gate at the start of their first heat. In other words, you can't earn points just by showing up, even if there are less than 5 competitors in your class.

Fee Changes

For entering a tournament bracket, in which only one heat is guaranteed (or two in the case of double-elimination):

- Entry fee of \$30.00 per driver, per class.

For use of the Sunday Fun Day Track, in which you can take as many practice laps as you can make within a 4+ hour window with no threat of elimination:

- Entry fee of \$79.99 per vehicle (up to 4 drivers allowed per vehicle).

As a reminder, participants may register for **either** the Sunday Fun Day Track **or** one of the competitive race classes. Once registration closes, participants will not be able to change events. The Sunday Fun Day Track will be reserved only for participants who sign up specifically for this event and participants will not have to worry about competitors who were eliminated from the competitive race brackets coming over and taking time on their track.

NOTE: The Sunday Fun Day Track event has sold out every single weekend that it has been offered. If you are interested in taking part, we highly recommend planning ahead and registering early, especially since we may need to limit entries based on ice conditions!
